Bus routes are established as per state statute ORS 327.043 – A school district is required to provide transportation for *elementary students who reside more than 1.0 miles from school* and for *secondary school students who reside more than 1.5 miles from school*.

### **STUDENTS GRADES 6-8 WHO LIVE IN THESE AREAS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN TRANSPORTATION:**

- \* North of Central Ave and in the area between the railroad tracks and the current East city limit;
- \* South of Central Ave and in the area between the railroad tracks and S. Grove (includes area from Lower Forest Heights, Waite St., City Park area, S. State St., and Valentine.)

### **STUDENTS GRADES 9-12 WHO LIVE IN THESE AREAS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN TRANSPORTATION:**

- \* North of Central Ave and in the area between the railroad tracks and the current East city limit;
- \* South of Central Ave and in the area between the railroad tracks and S. Grove (includes area from Lower Forest Heights, Waite St., City Park area, S. State St., Valley Court, Camas Ct., and Valentine.)

## Discipline Procedures for District-Approved Student Transportation - EEACC-AR

### Student Code of Conduct

The district will provide interpretation to those students/parents whose primary language is not English.

While riding a school bus, students will obey and follow rules set by the driver at all times; accept assigned seats; and answer to coaches, teachers and chaperons who are responsible for maintaining order on trips.

Students will:

1. Obey the drive at all times;
2. Not throw objects;
- 3\*\*. Not have in their possession any weapon as defined by Board policy JFCJ, Weapons in the schools;
- 4\*. Not fight, wrestle or scuffle;
- 5\*. Not stand up and/or move from seats while the bus is in motion;
- 6\*. Not extend hands, head, feet or objects from windows or doors;
- 7\*\*. Not possess matches or other incendiaries and concussion devices;
- 8\*. Use emergency exits only as directed by the driver;
- 9\*. Not damage school property or the personal property of others;
- 10\*. Not threaten or physically harm the driver or other riders;
- 11\*. Not do any disruptive activity which might cause the driver to stop in order to reestablish order;
- 12\*. Not make disrespectful or obscene statements;
- 13\*\*. Not possess and/or use tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs;
14. Not carry glass containers or other glass objects;
15. Not block aisles and passageways;
16. Accept assigned seats;
- 17\*\*\*. Answer to coaches, teachers and chaperons who are responsible for maintaining order on trips.

If using district transportation students will:

1. Stay away from the bus when it is moving;
2. Be at the bus stop five minutes before the scheduled pick up time (schedules will be posted on all buses.)

\* These regulations, if broken, are **SERIOUS** violations with serious consequences because of the threat to the safety of others.

\*\* These regulations, if broken are **SEVERE** violations and could be subject to district disciplinary matters, therefore subject to district procedures and handled as appropriate.

\*\*\* Coaches, teachers and chaperons: (1) must have a copy of the bus regulations and know them before going on a trip; and (2) must position themselves on the bus as to be in control of discipline at all times.
